As a grandmother, I was troubled by the statistics I've seen:

- 1 in 3 U.S. (ages 12-18) students say they have been bullied at school.
- 49% of children in grades 4–12 reported being bullied at least once during the past month.
- Middle schools students had experienced these various types of bullying: name calling (44%); teasing (43%); spreading rumors or lies (36%); pushing or shoving (32%); hitting, slapping, or kicking (29%); leaving out (28%); threatening (27%); stealing belongings (27%).
- Bullying affects all youth, including those who are bullied, those who bully others, and those who see bullying going on. Some effects may last into adulthood and is often seen in the corporate setting.
- Most bullying takes place in school, outside on school grounds, and on the school bus.

Isolation, as a result of bullying, is the primary cause of depression for our children today. Bullying must stop. At the root of all malice, all prejudices, and all bullying is the objectifying of others; how people view other people.



I wrote the books and provide workshops out of concern for our children. It seems impossible to make any difference. But what if we could actually change children's hearts and redirect their thinking and eventually their behavior by simply sharing a story? And what if that story was just the beginning of character development and building a community of peers who are committed not to treat people as objects?

It's possible, and it's happening thanks to a little lost dog named Louie!





